Start with the first letter in your name and align to the alphabetically ordered letters down the far left vertical axis. Circle content at the intersection of Column #1 and the appropriate Row for the letter. Next, your second letter gets aligned to Column #2, again circling content at the defined intersection. Everybody gets the free word of “triathlete” as the third word. Continue for 8 letters. Also, be sure to select the appropriate possessive pronoun that gets slotted just before Column #8. Here's an example for triathlete, Steve Jones:
